

Consider Volunteering as a **CASA**

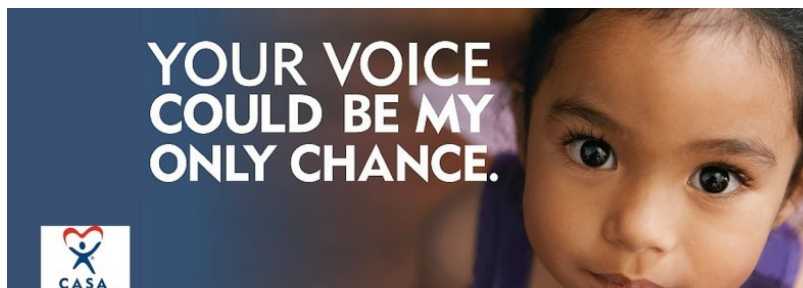
WHO: Court Appointed Special Advocates for Children (CASA) of Hancock County.
