FACT: IT'S NOT STRANGER DANGER


Research shows that the greatest risk to children doesn't come from strangers but from friends and family and only about 10% of children who are sexually abused are abused by strangers. People who abuse children look and act just like everyone else. In fact, they often go out of their way to appear trustworthy, seeking out settings where they can gain easy access to children, such as sports leagues, faith centers, clubs, and schools.

You can do your part by being observant and reporting any suspected child abuse to local authorities. Some signs a child may be abused are: withdrawal from friends or activities; changes in behavior; depression, anxiety or unusual fears; a sudden loss of self-confidence; frequent absences from school; reluctance to leave school activities; and attempts at running away.
