Baby Milestones

- Babies grow, learn, and reach developmental milestones through relationships and play.
- Developmental milestones track changes in babies as they learn to move, see, hear, communicate, and interact with others.
- Remember development happens over time. Differences among babies are usually nothing to worry about. If something does not seem quite right, it's important to request a referral so the child can be seen by a professional.
- It is important to remember babies born exposed to substances may have short or longterm effects. A Long-term effect may include problems with development, learning and behavior throughout childhood, adolescence, and adulthood.
